GNLU Alumna accepted to Judicial Fellowship Programme of the International Court of Justice

Gandhinagar, April 15, 2021: Ms Tanishtha Vaid, an alumna of Gujarat National Law University (GNLU), has been accepted to 2021-2022 Judicial Fellowship Programme of the International Court of Justice.

Following her undergraduate degree from GNLU in 2019, Tanishtha completed her LL.M. in International Legal Studies at New York University in 2020. Currently, she is a full-time International Finance and Development Fellow (Legal) at The Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD), Paris.

The Judicial Fellowship Programme of the International Court of Justice was established in 1999 to enable law graduates to gain experience working at the International Court of Justice in The Hague. Annually, a select group of students from across premier universities is appointed as fellows in the International Court of Justice's judicial wing. Tanishtha will be the first student from GNLU to hold this prestigious position.
