1st GNLU Essay Competition on Sports Law

Gandhinagar, September 01, 2020: In line with the Centre's objective of creating awareness among students about sports law and encourage them to explore deeper in the subject, the Centre for Sports and Entertainment Law (GCSEL) organised the 1st GNLU Essay Competition on Sports Law.

The main objective of the competition was to encourage legal research among students on contemporary sports law issues such as data protection in modern sport, international human rights in sport, sports betting, eSports, sports technology, finance in sport, dispute resolution mechanisms in sport, and relevant case analysis of sports disputes. A total of 60 submissions were made for the competition and the following were the winners of the competition:

Yash More and Sangita Sharma of GNLU won the first prize for their essay on Dispute Resolution of Sports in India – The need to establish a Sports Tribunal.

Soundarya Rajagopal of GNLU won the second prize for her essay on Doping in E-sports: emerging regulatory challenges.

The third Prize went to Meva Tandon and Paras Marya of National Law University, Jodhpur for her essay on Sports washing – Brushing Human Rights Violation under the rug.

Shreya Mishra of National University of Study and Research in Law, Ranchi bagged the First Honourable Mention for her essay on Sanctions: An effective tool for human rights while the second Honourable Mention went to Raghav Bhargava of GNLU for his essay on The Offside in Football: Understanding Child Labour.
